Responsibilities:

- Develop Individual Support Plans ensuring that individuals are involved in identifying and developing goals. Ensure that all documentation is completed in a timely manner as specified by both Agency and DDS policy and regulation.
- Develop and implement goal strategies and tracking mechanisms. Document progress on a monthly and quarterly basis.
- Complete and maintain all documentation related to support plans in a clear and well-organized manner.
- Train and support staff in the implementation of established goals for all individuals.
- Identify and address significant health, psychiatric and behavioral issues, schedule and attend appointments as needed
- Attend all team meetings for assigned individuals
- Support individuals in exercising control over their lives, including daily routines within their home and leisure activities.
- Support individuals in being fully integrated in their communities by assisting them in the use of community resources, establishing and maintaining personal relationships and facilitating opportunities to meet new people.
- Provide transportation to activities and appointments as needed.
- Assist individuals in maintaining their home. Perform housekeeping tasks as necessary.
- Administer and monitor individual medications in accordance with established regulations, policies and procedures.
- Maintain positive and collaborative working relationships with DDS, community agencies, and family members.
