- Instructs ABA Therapists on the proper implementation of educational and clinical behavior programs and plans, data collection systems and all necessary monitoring and reporting systems
- Conducts regular caregiver and/or teacher training and consultation
- Meets regularly with Director of ABS Behavioral Health Services and notifies them immediately of issues impacting client's progress and satisfaction
- Completes all necessary documentation and reports in a timely and satisfactory manner
- Oversees and directs the scheduling of Behavior Therapists
